


















HIGHBURY PLAYERS MEMBERSHIP RULES

-  The *Green Room* is for use by the company that is currently using the stage; it is used by the Players for two weeks before the opening, and during the run of a Highbury Players Production. The *Green Room* must not be used as a general social area.
-  The *Club Room* may be used as a room where refreshments can be made or as a meeting place during rehearsals in the Studio. The Club Room may be used by 'props' during a run and as a general social area for Highbury Players at other times.
-  Be aware of the theatre's smoking policy: see notices backstage and front-of-house.
-  Players must use the Stage Door for rehearsals and performances. All members entering the building must sign in, unless attending a rehearsal. For rehearsals, a register of attendance will be kept by the director, or by a person appointed by the director.
-  Work parties are held on Monday evenings and on Wednesdays during the day.
-  Actors in a production must not be seen front of house before a show, nor during the interval. Costume and makeup must be removed before entering the public areas after a performance.
-  Rehearsals are private to members of the cast and the crew. Visitors to rehearsals are not permitted unless agreed in advance with the Director and/or Stage Manager.
-  No food or drink in the auditorium during rehearsals or performances. Alcohol must not be drunk just before or during a show by any member of the cast or crew.
-  During rehearsals and performances, the stage must not be used as a corridor to the rear of the theatre. Peering through the main tabs when they are closed is prohibited at all times.
-  The audience has come to enjoy a theatrical experience. Do nothing to spoil it. Maintain silence at all times when waiting or working in the wings during a rehearsal or performance.
-  Highbury Little Theatre has a wonderful wardrobe. If you are privileged to be loaned costumes or accessories from it, you are expected to look after them properly during the run and to store them carefully at the end of each performance. Hand all items back at the time and place specified by the Wardrobe Coordinator.
-  All members of cast and crew are required to attend the strike party on the Sunday morning after the last night.
-  Unless agreed by the Management Committee all actors are required to be members before appearing in any Highbury Players production.
-  Highbury Players Management Committee reserves the right to refuse a new membership application, or to refuse to renew a membership, or to suspend a Player while alleged misconduct is investigated.
